In pursuance to the provision under Clause 6 (a) of Haryana Electric Vehicle Policy 2022 notified in Gazette *vide* No. No. 20/01/2022-4IB-I. dated 08.07.2022, the Governor of Haryana is pleased to notify scheme for grant of "Purchase Incentives to Buyers of Electric Vehicles" as per the details provided hereunder:

1. Objective of Scheme

This scheme offers fiscal benefits to the buyers of electric vehicle in order to ensure sufficient demand and enable wider adoption of electric vehicles in the State. Currently, Electric Vehicles have higher upfront costs than conventional vehicles and reducing the upfront cost can be crucial in making electric vehicles attractive to buyers.

2. Quantum of Assistance

Buyers of Electric Vehicle shall be provided with one-time Purchase Incentive to individuals within policy period as below:

	Hybrid Electric Car/ Hybrid Light EV (SHEV/PHEV) ranging from INR 40.00 lakh to INR 70.00 lakh	First 200 units purchased and registered in the state shall receive purchase incentive of 15% of the ex- showroom price of vehicle maximum up to INR 5.00 lakh.
5.	Hydrogen based vehicle	First 200 units purchased and registered in the state shall receive purchase incentive of 15% of the ex- showroom price of vehicle maximum up to INR 10.00 lakh .
6.	Electric Tractors for farmers	First 1000 units purchased and registered in the state shall receive purchase incentive of 50% of the ex- showroom price of vehicle up to INR 5.00 lakh.
	Hybrid Electric tractor for farmers	First 100 units purchased and registered in the state shall receive purchase incentive of 50% of the ex- showroom price of vehicle up to INR 5.00 lakh .
8.	Electric Bus	First 200 units purchased and registered in the state shall receive purchase incentive of 10% of the ex- showroom price of vehicle up to INR 10.00 lakh . *Incentives of 100 Electric buses shall be reserved for buses used by government and government owned entities of Haryana.

3. Definitions:

- i. **Electric Vehicle:** Electric Vehicle (EV) refers to automobiles powered by a battery and an electric motor, including battery electric vehicles (BEV) and Fuel Cell Electric Vehicle (FCEV).
- ii. **Battery Electric Vehicle (BEV)**: A vehicle which is powered exclusively by an electric motor; whose traction energy is supplied exclusively by traction battery installed in the vehicle; and has an Electric Regenerative Braking System'.
- iii. **Fuel Cell Electric Vehicle:** Fuel Cell Electric Vehicle (FCEV) use a propulsion system like that of electric vehicles, where energy stored as hydrogen is converted to electricity by the fuel cell.
- iv. Strong Hybrid Electric Vehicle: Strong Hybrid Electric Vehicle (SHEV) is a HEV which has an engine Stop-Start arrangement, 'Electric Regenerative Braking System' and a 'Motor Drive' (motor alone is capable to propel/drive the vehicle from a stationary condition).
- v. **Plug-in Hybrid Electric vehicle:** PHEV is a type of 'Strong Hybrid Electric Vehicle' which has a provision for 'Off Vehicle Charging' (OVC) of 'Rechargeable Energy Storage System (ReESS)'.
- vi. **Electric Regenerative Braking System:** An integrated vehicle braking system which provides for the conversion of vehicle kinetic energy into electrical energy during braking.
- vii. **Engine 'Stop-Start' arrangement**: A system by which the engine is started or stopped in a hybrid electric vehicle by vehicle control unit at operating conditions depending upon traction power required for the propulsion of the vehicle.
- viii. **Off Vehicle Charging (OVC):** Rechargeable Energy Storage System (ReESS) in the vehicle has a provision for external charging.

4. Eligibility

- i. Only category of vehicles mentioned in clause 2 of this scheme and clause 6. a of the "Haryana Electric Vehicle Policy 2022" shall be eligible for incentives.
- ii. An individual shall be entitled to claim incentives for only one electric vehicle from any of the categories as listed at clause 2 above
- iii. User shall not have claimed incentive under FAME or any other State/Central Govt. policy pertaining to the applied electric vehicle.
- iv. Incentives shall be made available on the basis of "**first registered and first applied**" basis. Users shall have to apply within 45 days of registration of vehicle (or IT enablement of this scheme) whichever is later, post which any claim of incentive under this policy shall be forfeited. There is no provision of relaxation of this timeline in the policy/scheme.
- v. Buyers who have purchased eligible electric vehicles between 10.07.2022 and launch of online portal for application shall have to apply within 45 days of launch of online application.

- vi. Incentives shall be made available in the form of direct transfer in the account of user as per bank details provided in the application form by the buyer.
- vii. Any vehicle claiming incentive under this policy should be mandatorily registered within the state of Haryana under prevailing Center Motor Vehicle Rules in Haryana.
- viii. Incentives under this policy shall be available only to individuals. Company, Corporation, Partnership Firm, Proprietorship Firm, etc. shall not be eligible for any incentive.
- ix. Any Government or Public Sector Unit shall also not be eligible for any incentives under the Policy except in case of electric buses for which a special provision has been made in the Haryana Electric Vehicle policy 2022 (Clause 6.a).
- x. All the incentives shall be made available online from the website with no requirement of any face-to-face visit.

5. Commencement and applicability

The Scheme shall commence with effect from 10.07.2022 for the Purchase Incentives to Buyers of Electric Vehicles and shall remain in operation for a period of 05 years. The assistance shall be admissible on eligible vehicles, purchased on or after 10.07.2022, till 09.07.2027 or completing of the target number of vehicles incentivized as mentioned in the policy.

6. Submission and processing of Applications:

The applicant shall apply online on the web portal of Department of Industries &Commerce, Haryana.

7. Procedure

The individuals will be required to apply on the website of Department of Industries & Commerce, Haryana within 45 days of registration of vehicle or within 45 days of launch of IT portal for the scheme, whichever is later.

The following documents shall be required for the purpose of registration/considering eligibility of their EVs / Hybrid EVs for incentive under this Policy as per Form U1 at Annexure I of this policy:

- Aadhar Card of buyer
- Registration Certificate / Registration Number of the vehicle
- Purchase memo No/ Invoice No/Transaction No, etc.
- Undertaking (Annexure II to be accepted while applying online)
- Cancelled Cheque

Following are the general guidelines regarding application procedure:

- i. Application shall be processed and examined by the office of Director General / Director, Department of Industries & Commerce, Haryana. They will be responsible for scrutiny and approval/rejection of the incentive after scrutinizing the application.
- ii. In case of rejection, applications will not be entertained again.
- iii. The applicant shall not be required to submit any additional document other than unless required for establishing genuineness of the claim.

8. Timelines for processing of application:

Time limit for approval in case where no deficiency is found – 30 days.

9. Competent Authority for Sanction:

The Director General / Director, Department of Industries & Commerce, Haryana shall be the competent authority for sanction of incentives.

10. Interpretation of Rules:

Administrative Secretary, Department of Industries & Commerce, Haryana shall be competent to make interpretation of provisions of this scheme, if need be.

11. Appeals

Appeal against orders passed by the competent authority shall lie with Administrative Secretary, Department of Industries & Commerce, Haryana within a period of 30 days from the date of communication of orders appealed against. The order passed by the Administrative Secretary in appeal shall be final. Appeal can be submitted in a written format at the office of the Administrative Secretary, Industries & Commerce, Haryana with subject as "Appeal for Purchase Incentives to Buyers of Electric Vehicles under the Haryana Electric Vehicle Policy – 2022."

12. Penal Action

In case, it is found at any stage that the applicant has claimed the assistance on the basis of wrong facts, the applicant shall, besides refunding the assistance with compound rate of interest @12% per annum and facing legal action, be debarred from the grant of any incentive/assistance from the State Government in future.
