Entrepreneurship Development Programme for Scheduled Caste

OBJECTIVES

In the era of economic development, there is a need for every one to be a partner in the development process. Fast industrialization and growth of service sector have opened many new opportunities in the State. Little orientation and the zeal for growth can be induced among the budding entrepreneurs. For years together the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes were not provided due opportunities to grow with the advancement of technology. For their social and economic upliftment, a booster does in the form of special incentives to encourage them to become entrepreneurs and to start their own industrial and service venture is necessary. Further, time has come that instead of seeking employment, the enterprising persons should become a source of employment by setting up industries of their own and give employment to others. On the part of Government, it is necessary to encourage SC/ST beneficiaries to join the main stream of industry by giving them special incentives. State Govt. has decided to provide the incentives and concessions through the following schemes:-

BENEFICIARIES

State Government has decided to take effective steps to promote entrepreneurship for rapid industrialization of the State in general and for Scheduled Caste beneficiaries in particular. As per the scheme EDP will be organized with special focus on S.C. rural youth and women. Non Government organization and industries Association will be fully involved in finalizing the curriculum for organizing EDPs.

It is proposed to formulate a scheme organizing Entrepreneurship Development Programme for the S.C. entrepreneurs at district level. In each ^{dist} at least One EDP will be conducted for atleast 35 beneficiaries. The duration of the programme will be of 4 weeks. In a year atleast 30 EDP programmes will be organized. District Faridabad, Gurgaon and Sonapat which have more potential will organize two EDPs whereas rest of the districts will organize one EDP. By adopting this methodology, 1050 Scheduled Caste beneficiaries will be imparted basic training for running their venture successfully. The curriculum of EDP will be

finalized in consultation with HIPA, Gurgaon, SISI Karnal, Haridicon and industrial Associations of the concerned district. The financing pattern of each EDP will be as under:

1.	Advertisement and publicity expenses through Newspaper, local paper, pamphlets, letters to the various development deptt./offices, banks, Educational institutions.	15,000.00
2.	Inauguration & Valedictory	5,000.00
3.	Postage	2,000.00
4.	Stationery & Printing (Study material & notes)	5,000.00
5.	Honorarium of faculty @ Rs.400/- (Per person per lecture).	19,000.00
6.	Stipend of trainees @ 1000/-	35,000.00
7.	Expenses of factory field visits.	5,000.00
8.	Evaluation reports (to be prepared after 2-3 months of training to assess the impact)	3,000.00
9.	Tea, Snacks to trainees and trainer	7,000.00
10.	Miscellaneous	4,000.00

Total expenditure to organize one programme will be paid about Rs.1,00,000/- and for 30 programmes it will be 30.00 lacs.
